

Quick Composing Tourney

Mate in 2 moves

Orthodox directmate two-mover (#2)

No fairy pieces or conditions.

Theme: Mate in 2 moves. There must be at least two phases. In every phase the white gives one (no more) flight square for black king. The flight square in every phase must be different. The refutation can't be the move of black king in the flight square.

Мат в два хода. Не менее двух фаз, в каждой белые предоставляют королю черных одно (не больше) свободное поле. Свободные поля различные, ход короля на предоставленное свободное поле не может быть опровержением.

Matas dviem ėjimais. Ne mažiau dviejų fazių. Kiekvienoje baltieji suteikia juodųjų karaliui vieną (ne daugiau) laisvą laukelį. Laisvi laukeliai skirtingi, karaliaus ėjimas į suteiktą laisvą laukelį negali būti paneigimu.

The tourney is open for Congress participants only. Maximum two compositions per author (including joint) are allowed.

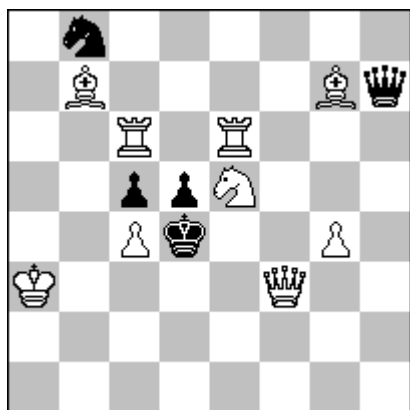
